

THE FINE ARTS LIBRARY OF THE ART GUILD

The Art Guild's Library consists of over 300 cataloged books, as well as a variety of dvd's, pamphlets, and magazines on a wide variety of topics of interest to artists. It functions as a resource for the working artist-member. The current collection includes titles on the history of art, color, line, drawing and techniques. The artist will find how-to's on a variety of media: acrylics, pastels, pencil, watercolor and oil, as well as books on a wide variety of 3-dimensional art and photography. The collection is primarily used by the members of the Guild to enhance their own artistic endeavors.

How To Use The Art Guild Member Library

The Art Guild members are welcome to enjoy the 300+ books, videos, dvd's and magazines of the circulating Guild Library. Simply make a selection, find the book card and write today's date, your name and phone number on it. File it by the author (or first line on the card) in the blank card box. Magazines and pamphlets are filed in front. When you are finished with the item, simply place it in the return basket located on the bookshelves.

Also included in the collection are items that discuss techniques of painting a wide variety of subjects, from landscapes to human subjects. Three-dimensional art and photography are represented, as well as ART HISTORY and COLLECTIONS of individual artists and/or famous museum or gallery collections.
