

Open Studio Guidelines

One of the benefits of membership in the Fairfield Glade Art Guild is the use of studio space. **Mondays** are designated as open studio days. This means on Mondays during the normal operating hours of the Plateau Creative Arts Center members may use the studio space to work on their art for FREE. Non members may also use the studio space for a fee of \$5/day.

Beyond the obvious bonus of having more space to work, artists also enjoy companionship and opportunities for peer review of art work when working in the studio. So bring your art supplies and come enjoy the studio, make some new friends and create beautiful art.

Below are some important rules to follow when working in the studio.

- Do not use any items in the cabinets without permission from the Studio Manager
- Please leave the studio clean
- Return tables and chairs
- Clean sink
- Wipe down tables and countertops
- Sweep and vacuum floors
- Empty trash cans
- Be responsible with hazardous solvents and oils by taking them home and disposing of them correctly. The same goes for latex and acrylic paints. Small amounts of water soluble paints may be washed down the drain with plenty of water.
- There are tablecloths to protect the tables in the walk-in closet
- Buckets for waste paint are under the sink
- Cleaning supplies are located under the sink and in the walk-in closet
- Brooms and dustpans are in the kitchen
- Vacuum cleaner is in the walk-in closet

There is a Keurig coffee maker in the kitchen with pods, the donation jar for coffee is on the kitchen counter.
